Stabling: Bedding not provided – shavings available for purchase. Permanent stalls and vinyl temporary stalls with doors (minimum 10 X 10), both under roof. Stallions, horses over 17 hands and entries showing for entire weekend will be given preference for permanent stalls. Please pre-order any shavings needed. Stalls will be available on Friday at 3 pm.

*****NEW STABLING POLICY for this show to benefit the student IDA TEAM:**

There will be a \$25 stall cleaning deposit for all stalls. If you have cleaned out/stripped your stall at the end of the show day, you will receive your deposit back in full. Please provide a separate check payable to LEC for stall deposits. Stall not cleaned by competitors will be cleaned by IDA team riders and the \$25 deposit goes to the IDA team.

- Friday 3 pm through Saturday (stall or tack) \$25.00
- REQUIRED Stall Cleaning Deposit \$25.00 – SEPARATE CHECK please
- Bedding if ordered on entry (wood shavings, per bag) \$ 9.00
- Bedding if purchased on grounds \$ 10.00
- ***We must know stabling needs by September 10, 2019 with entry forms.

Trailer-in: \$10 haul in fee each time, per horse

Please note the following:

- ASTM/SEI approved headgear is required for all riders and must be worn while mounted.
- The show will be run according to USEF rules as much as possible.
- Lake Erie College and its employees will not be held responsible for loss or damage to persons, property, or horse.
- Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. No smoking is allowed in any buildings or stables.
- All dogs must be on a leash which is held by a person. Owners will be fined \$50 if dog is not on a leash. Dogs are not allowed in the Learning Center.
- Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments
- Refunds will only be issued with a vet note explaining horse's illness or lameness. NO REFUNDS for stabling or office fees.
- Ride times will be posted at <http://www.lec.edu/equine-events> by September 18, 2019.

- All horses must have a current negative Coggins (within 12 months of the date of show) with the same horse name submitted on the entry form. Show numbers will not be issued without a current Coggins test.

At the Show

Wash and disinfect your hands frequently!

Do not handle or pet horses other than your own.

Do not let your horse touch other horses, particularly nose-to-nose.

Do not share water buckets, feed tubs, tack or other equipment between horses.

You may elect to take temperatures on your horses twice daily. Report any temperatures over 102.0 to the Show Manager.

Going Home

Clean and disinfect your tack, boots, equipment and grooming supplies.

When you get home, shower, blow your nose and put on clean clothes and shoes before going near other horses at home.
