



Dear Competitors, Trainers & Owners, Important Show Information

Following and attached are **important and helpful information** that will hopefully make your weekend, however HOT, a little more informed and organized.

Jackets Waived

The forecast of high temperatures have prompted the show to waive jackets for the weekend. Cooling vests are allowed. See the rule that follows:

DR120.8.Management can announce prior to or during a competition that competitors can show without jackets when extreme heat and/or humidity is forecast. This waiver applies to all classes including FEI classes at National Competitions. However, competitors must wear protective headgear and a shirt with sleeves and collar, without neckwear, and without decoration except as described under .15 below. T-shirts are not permitted.

14. Cooling vests may be worn underneath a riding jacket. If coats are waived, a solid-colored cooling or lightweight vest may be worn over a riding shirt as specified in DR120.8.

15. When sponsorship is permitted in accordance with GR1306, the name and/or logo of the individual's sponsor(s) may appear on each of the two sides of jackets or top garments at the height of breast pockets not exceeded 80 cm² in size. Logos described under DR121.1 are also permitted as above.

Parking

Detailed Parking Map attached: Please see map included in this email for parking specifics. We have to get a lot of trailers parked in a short period of time so it will be important to follow the directions of the attendants. All trailers should be parked and angled to pull forward when ready to leave.

- Arrive Friday beginning at 12:00PM
- Horse Trailers enter the venue from the Snyder Rd. entrance.
- Proceed to the unloading area.
- Form two parallel lines in the unloading area.
- Unload as quickly as possible and proceed to park your trailer
- There will be several parking attendants available to direct and help you through the process.

We realize that it will be hot and uncomfortable. We will do everything we can to help you get unloaded as quickly as possible. We have included a map showing the parking areas for trailers and for cars in both the main parking area and also the parking lot off of Washington Street.

Parking Permit/Contact Information: In the event that we find it necessary to contact you because of an issue with your vehicle or trailer, please help us by filling out the included form with your contact information. Place under your windshield whipper.

Stall map and assignments

Also included is a stall map and a stall assignment list. Each stall will have a label on it with the competitor's name, horse's name and group. There is also a line at the bottom of the label for the appropriate **emergency contact information.**

New for this year at CVF

- Additional electric installed on the right hand side of the stall barn.
- There are three new wash wracks outside at the left corner of the stall barn.
- Competitors have use of the large indoor arena on Saturday and Sunday

Awards schedule is included here and also in your competitor's packet the awards schedule.

- Emergency information is in your program, posted in the barn, show office and the venue office
- Report venue issues to the office/show management
- Keep yourselves and your horses hydrated
