

## 2017 NODA Lead Line Class Test & Instructions

- All riders/leaders enter the ring and line up near A, facing C.  
(If class is large, please ride up long side to ensure good spacing between horses.)
- Judge will use the Lead Line Test Sheet below to “score” riders.
- Judge will call competitors by number and name of horse and rider. Each rider will individually ride the following Lead Line Test. (The amount of control of horse depends on the “horse leaders” best judgment.)
- Each show will have a different Lead Line Class judge
- Riders receive their Lead Line Test score sheet and and ribbons at the end of the class.
- Photographers - please stay outside the competition arena

Lead Line Test	Score	Judge’s Directives	Comments
X Enter, G Halt and Salute (salute optional)		Checkmark if horse stops Star if salute attempted (Write Good Salute if it is close to a salute)	
C Turn Left		Checkmark or Star if rider is influencing the turn	
H to E Continue at Walk Few steps of trot (optional)		Check mark for everyone Star if there are trot steps	
E Turn Left		Checkmark	
X Turn Right Return to Lineup		Checkmark	
Collective marks:			
Heels down		Checkmark if legs/heels in good position Star if heels/legs in really good position	
Rein contact		Dash if not holding reins Checkmark if holding reins Star if holding reins correctly	
Harmony of horse & rider		Star = really good and comment “Good balance!”
