Valley Riding Press Release:

About 40 years ago, Lakewood Stables was the place to go for trail rides, horse rentals, and riding lessons. What many people don't know is that the stable is still in operation today, managed by a non-profit organization called Valley Riding, Inc. Tucked in the Rocky River valley in the Cleveland Metroparks, Valley Riding, Inc. operates in the Rocky River Reservation providing horseback riding lessons, a Therapeutic Riding Program accredited by the North American Riding for the Handicapped Association (NAHRA), pony and horse camps, private horse boarding, and several other programs that help Cleveland's "city-dwelling" public enjoy and appreciate horses.

Because Valley Riding is a non-profit affiliate of the Cleveland Metroparks, the organization relies on the proceeds of fundraising events, donations, and grants to supplement Therapeutic Riding Program lesson program fees and keep the school horses fed and cared for year-round. Bring your family to the Rocky River Stables on Sunday, August 7th and celebrate the world of horses, nature, and the outdoors with demonstrations and activities that will delight kids of all ages. Whether you're already a "horse person" or have only appreciated the beauty of horses from afar, you're sure to enjoy a day spent learning more about these majestic animals. Horse Festival activities include pony rides for the kids and demonstrations on various types of horseback riding, including western reining, stadium jumping, and dressage. The always delightful Valley Riding horse quadrille team will perform precision movements to music, and our TRP riders will show their riding skills as well. Games for all ages, including a raffle and \$500 cash prize "Barnyard Bingo," which has to be seen to be believed, will make for a fun-filled day for the whole family. Grounds open at 11AM; admission is free and parking is just a \$5 donation per car. Check out Valley Riding and their "spokespony" Scooter Pie on Facebook for additional information.

"Lakewood Stables" is now known as Rocky River Stables.

Located at the bottom of Puritas Road hill, the facility is currently home to nearly 30 school horses and ponies and a number of privately-owned, boarded horses. The unique combination of a convenient location close to major highways, direct access to bridle trails, an indoor arena, and two outdoor arenas makes this barn an excellent place to learn to ride or board your horse. The school horses at Rocky River include both donated and purchased horses whose prior lives include racing, eventing, stadium jumping, western pleasure, trail, and dressage. Although many are Quarter Horses, the "schoolies" include a large variety of ponies (including Welsh Ponies, a Pony of the Americas, and a Chincoteague), Haflingers, Thoroughbreds, Paints, two Percheron draft horses, and more.

For the youngest budding equestrians, Valley Riding's Pony Camps are an excellent introduction to horses and riding for kids age 4 to 7 years. Campers learn general care and safety rules used in working around the ponies and in the barn. Campers help to groom their ponies before riding. There is one instructor for each class, and one volunteer for each student. Volunteers assist the campers at all times, and lead the ponies whenever a student is mounted. For older kids and adults, Horse Camp teaches the same care and safety concepts with riding instruction each session. Both Pony and Horse Camps are five, two-hour sessions.

During the summer, groups of kids from Cleveland, Lakewood, and other suburbs visit Valley Riding's stables to participate in Youth Outdoors 4-H Adventure Clubs. Through these clubs, urban youth get to explore a variety of adventure activities such as horseback riding, hiking, biking, nature exploration, backpacking, and kayaking. Valley Riding provides a one week session during which the clubbers learn basic horse care, tack care, barn safety, and beginner riding. The Rocky River Stables barns offer two-hour long programs for local Girl Scout troops as well. One hour is spent in the arena in a beginning riding lesson. A second hour is spent touring the barn and learning basic horse care.

Lake Erie College Intercollegiate Dressage Team 2011 National Champions!

Barbara Soukup, NODA member and LEC IDA coach is proud to report that the 2011 Lake Erie College IDA Team were national champions at the April 30-May 1 Intercollegiate Dressage Association's National Championship in Newberry, FL. This hard working LEC IDA team won the 2011 Region Championship to qualify for the Nationals. Over 100 Riders from more than 20 colleges and universities competed as teams and individuals in four divisions: Intro., Lower training, Upper training and 1st level. Unlike traditional dressage competition where riders show on their own horses, IDA shows require that the host school provide the horses and tack, and riders choose their horses through random draw. Riders compete on unfamiliar horses with only 10 min. of warm-up time to establish a relationship before entering the show ring. Officials for the 2011 event are USDF "S" Judge Charlotte Trentlemam, of Ocala, FL, and "R" judge Lisa Payne of Wellington, FL.

The Northern Ohio Dressage Association and Lake Erie College are pleased to announce a clinic with Reese Koffler-Stanfield, successful FEI Dressage Rider and USDF Certified Instructor/Trainer. The clinic will be held October 29 and 30, 2011 at the Lake Erie College Equestrian Center.

Reese's riding and training career has progressed from a

successful Advanced Young Rider to a nationally and

internationally ranked professional High Performance competitor. She has earned USDF Bronze, Silver and Gold Medals and is a USDF Certified Instructor/Trainer through Fourth Level, which is the highest USDF certification currently available. Among her many accomplishments, she has been a demo rider at two USDF National Symposiums and was chosen to participate in the inaugural Hilltop Young Horse Trainers' Conference.

Reese's current Grand Prix partner is Goubergh's Kasper, a 16.3h Dutch Warmblood gelding. In 2010 they ranked in the top 20 in the fight for a spot on the WEG team and placed fourth in the Grand Prix Freestyle in the Kentucky Cup CDI*** and Lamplight CDI***.
