

USDF Mourns the Loss of 2015 Lifetime Achievement Award Winner Lloyd Landkamer



exington, KY (September 28, 2015) -The United States Dressage Federation is sad to report that 2015 USDF Lifetime Achievement Award Recipient Lloyd Landkamer passed away Friday, September 5. Lloyd's passing will leave a sizeable void in the dressage and paraequestrian

communities, both nationally and internationally.

Throughout the years, Lloyd has served as a manager, secretary, technical delegate, and FEI steward for a number of national and international competitions. He is best known for serving as manager of the dressage and para-equestrian competitions at the 2010 World Equestrian Games, USEF Festival of Champions, USEF Young Horse Championships, the Global Dressage Festival, numerous Great American/USDF Regional Championships, and most recently the US Dressage Finals. In addition to being a USEF 'R' Technical Delegate, C1 and C2 'R' Steward, and FEI Level 3 Steward, Lloyd was also the consummate volunteer. Throughout the years, Lloyd has served on the USDF Executive Board, USEF Dressage Committee, USEF Para Technical Committee and numerous other USEF and USDF committees.

In addition to being named 2002 USDF Volunteer of the Year, earning his USDF Bronze Medal, and being recognized nationally for his success in dressage sport horse breeding, Lloyd has been named the recipient of the 2015 USDF Lifetime Achievement Award. This award is presented to longtime USDF members who have shown a lifetime of dedication to the organization through volunteering and developing programs, projects, and committees that have contributed to USDF's mission. The 2015 Lifetime Achievement Award recognition will take place at the 2015 Adequan/USDF Annual Convention in Las Vegas, in December. Lloyd will also be featured with other recipients in the Roemer Foundation/USDF Hall of Fame, Landkamer located at the USDF National Education Center in Lexington, KY. (Continued on Page 9)

Classes are offered for registered Arabians and Half-Arabians in Dressage training level through Grand Prix, Western Dressage, Sport Horse In-Hand shown on the triangle, Sport Horse Under Saddle, Show Hack, Carriage Driving and a full complement of

Hunter Over Fences and Jumper classes, all having both amateur and open divisions. Most classes require qualifying scores to attend.

The dressage portion of the show ran three rings for six days with scoring six judges

more than 600 rides. Officiating were USEF judges Natalie Lamping, Marilyn Heath, Carol Bishop, Angela

Jessica Litt rode her purebred Arabian gelding Dance Fevor++// to a National Championship, two Reserve National Championships, and two additional Top Tens at

first and second levels. WWA Colino+/, owned by Karen Potts and trained and ridden by Danielle Blymier Hebler earned a Top Ten at Level Second finished just out of the ribbons with a very good score at Third Level.

Not to be outdone, Wendy Gruskiewicz rode Solvarian+ to a third place award in Western Dressage Basic and a

fourth place finish in Western Dressage First Level with the inaugural classes boasting 22 and 19 entries respectively.

The charismatic bay giant won another National Championship trophy on the lead with Jessica Litt in the In-Hand Amateur to Handle. He also earned Top Tens in Carriage Turnout, Carriage Working and Top Ten in-hand open out of 30 entries. Riften+++// also rocked the dressage ring with 11th and 13th place finishes at Training and First with Danielle.

Also in the coliseum, Danielle rode **WWA** Colino+/ to an amazing win in the 28 entry purebred Arabian Show Hack, judged by Margaret Freeman and James Reynolds. Danielle came back the next day and was named Reserve National Champion with Solvarian+ in the Sport Horse Under Saddle class with 51 entries.

At the end of the week, the team from DB Sporthorses/ Mithra **Training** Stable earned four National Championships, three Reserve National Championships and nineteen Top Ten awards. The championship awards include a very large pewter finish Arabian Horse statue on

a wood base, a red rose blanket and an impressive tricolor rosette. Reserve champions receive a bronze finish
