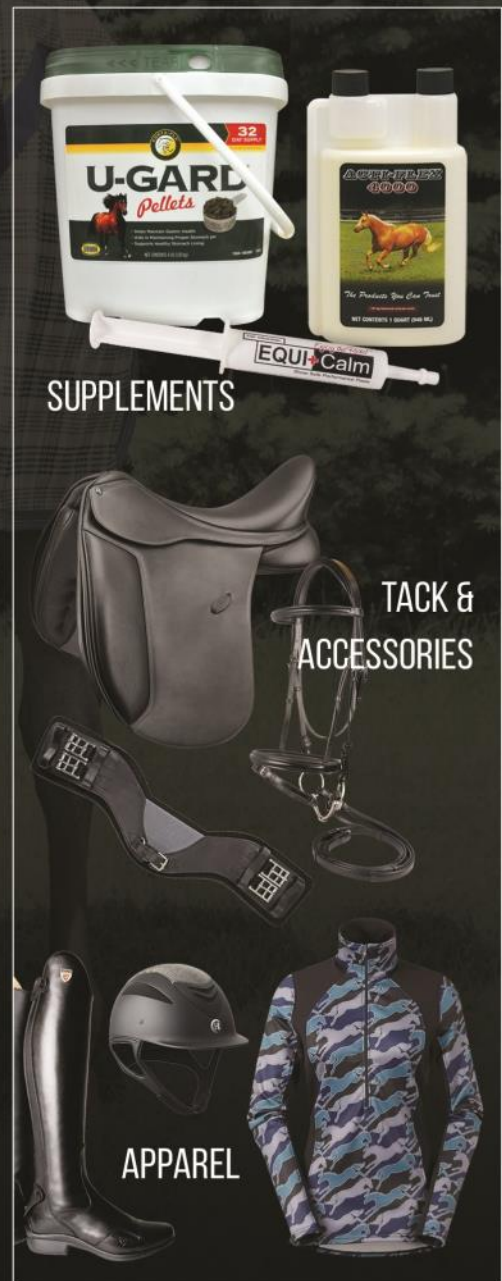
The Geauga County Dog Shelter is a no-kill shelter. Their wish list includes canned/dry dog and cat food,

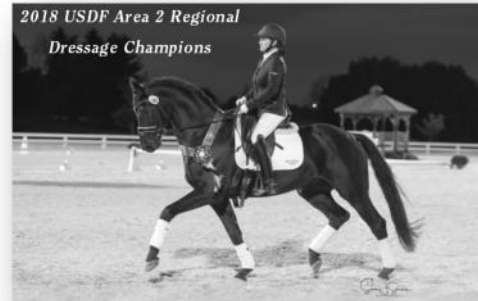

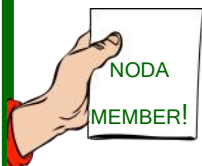
